## Coolidge, Arizona

Local Area Points of Interest

Coolidge is the commercial center of Arizona's cotton industry. In 1925, after construction of the Coolidge Dam transformed the flat desert into rich farm land, R. J. Jones laid out an 80-acre site to found the city.

Incorporated in 1945, the city now covers nine square miles and has more than 7,200 residents. The warm, dry climate makes it an ideal tourist and retirement community.
